Dear Band Parent/Guardian:

I am writing to inform you that your child has expressed an interest in auditioning for the Rhode Island Music Educators (RIMEA) **Junior All-State Band and/or Orchestra**.

The RIMEA Junior All-State Festival is one of the best festivals that we have in Rhode Island. It serves to challenge the students and motivate them to succeed. While not every student who auditions is accepted, the student is given the opportunity to experience the music audition process and more importantly, spend some time with and receive some invaluable teaching tips from professional musicians.

The RIMEA Junior All-State Festival involves instrumental and vocal students in grades 7 through 9 from area schools all over Rhode Island. In order to audition, instrumental students are expected to prepare a piece of music selected from an approved list. They must also memorize eight scales, as well as, read a piece of music they have never seen before. This is called sight-reading.

There are several groups for which each student is eligible: All-State Concert Band; All-State Orchestra; All-State Jazz Band; and/or Honors Band. Placement in to one of these ensembles is dependent on the student's ranking.

If accepted, the students will then participate in one short read through rehearsal and a weekend festival that involves two days of substantial rehearsal time and ending with a formal concert for family and friends.

The competition at this festival is very high, so while not required, it is highly recommended that students auditioning for Junior All-State should obtain the help of a private teacher.

A detailed schedule is listed on the next page, as well as information regarding the date, fee and location of the festival.
