Attention all RMS Students, Families and Faculty! The 8th Grade Needs YOUR HELP!

The 8th grade is planning to attend the film "May Your Memory Be Love: The story of Ovadia Baruch" presented by the Holocaust Education & Resource Center of Rhode Island in April. This film will tie in with our study of the Holocaust as we read the play "The Diary of Anne Frank". The movie is presented free of charge at the Showcase Cinemas in Warwick, but the transportation to and from the movie is not. In order to offset the cost of transportation we are holding a **cake pop fundraiser** to benefit all 8th grade students at next week's Valentine's Dance on Friday February 10th.

In order for this fundraiser to be successful, we are looking for donations and volunteers to help make the cake pops. We will need the following materials to make the pops:

- Boxed cake mix
- Frosting

- Sprinkles* (For decoration, but not needed)

If you are interested in donating any of the above materials, we ask that you deliver them to RMS by **Monday February 6th** so that we will have enough time to make the pops before Friday. If you would like to be even more involved with our fundraiser, we would ask that you bake the cake before bringing it to RMS to help decrease the number of cakes that we will need to bake.

Finally, and most importantly, if you would like to donate your time to help make the cake pops as a part of our CAKE POP SQUAD, we would love the help! We will be making the pops Tuesday-Friday after school next week from 2:30 - 3:30 as long as we have enough materials to keep us busy for that long!
